Your medical history and general health

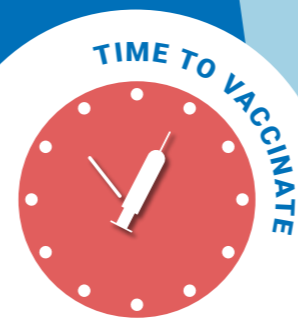


Your type of accommodation

Why vaccinate?

Travel vaccines are an important part of travel preparation.



They protect you from serious diseases,



prevent the spread of illness,



help you meet entry requirements to some countries



and, above all, give you peace of mind.



Check your destination!

Some countries ask for proof of vaccination before allowing entry.

For example, Muslims travelling to Saudi Arabia for the Hajj pilgrimage require a vaccination certificate. And many countries in Africa and South America require a yellow fever vaccination certificate. Without this proof, you might be denied entry or be obliged to quarantine.



Check the vaccination requirements for every country or region before you travel.



Book an appointment with your healthcare provider in advance.

Some vaccines require multiple doses, so book your appointment as soon as possible.



So think about vaccination, especially if you are travelling to Africa, Asia and South America.
